He was born in Istanbul in 1969 and completed his primary, secondary, and high school education in the same city. He graduated from Trakya University Faculty of Medicine and subsequently pursued his Child Health and Diseases Specialization at Şişli Hamidiye Etfal Training and Research Hospital. After completing his pediatrics specialization in 1996, he worked as a chief assistant in the same hospital. He also completed his Neonatology subspecialty at Şişli Hamidiye Etfal Training and Research Hospital between 2003 and 2006.

As the first neonatal specialist within the Ministry of Health in Turkey, he fulfilled his civil service obligation in Diyarbakır before returning to Şişli Hamidiye Etfal Training and Research Hospital to work as a neonatal specialist. He received the title of Associate Professor in 2012. In 2013, he became the Clinical Training Officer of the Newborn Clinic and served as the Hospital Manager of Şişli Hamidiye Etfal Training and Research Hospital between 2013 and 2015. He became a professor in 2023.

Apart from his medical qualifications, he has also completed a Master's Degree in Hospital Management. He is currently working as an Invited Lecturer in Health Insurance Systems Consultancy in the Netherlands. He has been honored with numerous awards, including the Presidential State Charter of the Republic of Turkey and the Prime Ministry Human Rights Award. He has also edited 5 books, authored 30 book chapters, and published over 200 international and national scientific articles. He has presented nearly 800 oral/written presentations and served as a speaker at more than 100 congresses and conferences. Additionally, he has managed more than 50 national and international congresses and courses.

In 2016, he co-founded the Children's Friends Association. He is currently working as a faculty member at Şişli Hamidiye Etfal Training and Research Hospital Newborn Clinic. He is married and has two sons.
